Confidentiality All financial aid information supplied by the applicant is considered confidential and will not be made available to any individual or entity not directly connected with granting financial aid at Hebrew College.

Eligibility Financial aid is awarded on the basis of need to students who have been accepted into most of Hebrew College's degree or certificate programs and to matriculated degree or certificate candidates in good standing. Matriculated students must reapply for aid each year. All financial aid granted by the College applies only to tuition.

Deadline Students seeking admission to a degree or certificate program: Your financial aid application should be submitted with your admissions application. If you defer enrollment, a new financial aid application will be required by March 1 prior to the planned start of your program. Matriculated students: You must reapply for financial aid each year. Completed applications, including all items in the checklist below, are due March 1 each year.

Application Checklist All of the following material must be completed before your request for financial aid will be considered. All items below with the exception of the FAFSA must be submitted with your Financial Aid Application. You may submit by sending hardcopy, email or fax. No aid will be awarded until the application is complete.

- Answer all questions on this form, sign and date the form. Remember to write clearly.
- Complete the online Free Application for Federal Student Aid (Fafsa) after January 1. (The information requested by Fafsa is based on the taxes you will be filing on the upcoming April 15.) If you are applying for the December 15 early decision deadline, please complete the Fafsa as soon as possible after January 1. For more information and the online Fafsa application form, visit www.fafsa.ed.gov. The Fafsa information will be sent to the college automatically. The Hebrew College code is 002157.
- Attach a copy of your federal income tax form. If you are applying by March 1, this is the tax form due the coming April 15. If you are applying for early decision, please forward these tax returns as soon as they are available.
- If you are NOT required to file federal income taxes, please attach a signed and dated statement to this effect.
- If there is any other relevant information that would help us to understand your needs, please attach a typed statement on a separate sheet.
