## Selection of Candidates

Admissions decisions are based on a careful review of a candidate's completed application, credentials, supporting documents and appropriateness for the degree program. Applicants must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a GPA of 3.0 or above. Hebrew College admits qualified students without regard to age, sex, religion, disability, race, color or national origin.

## Application Submission

Interested students must apply to both Hebrew College and the Pardes Institute. The admissions departments of both institutions communicate to evaluate student applications. Additionally, the institutions communicate regarding administration and academic and student services.

## Application Checklist

All applicants must submit the following materials:

- A completed, signed application form.
- A nonrefundable application fee of \$50.
- Official transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate studies from accredited academic institutions. Please have official copies of transcripts forwarded directly from the issuing institution to the Office of Admissions, Shoolman Graduate School of Jewish Education, 160 Herrick Rd., Newton Centre, MA, 02459.
- Copies of essays written for the Pardes application.
- Hebrew College will receive copies of your letters of reference from Pardes.
